Even though we only had one day in London, we managed to see Big Ben, the London Eye, Tower Bridge and Covent Garden, where we had some free time to go shopping.

On Saturday we spent time with our host families and got to see an Oxford College from the inside or got to know a bit more about Didcot.

Then it was already time to say goodbye to our penpals and host families on Sunday.
